

Converting RAW Files to JPEG With ViewNX2

- 1) Open ViewNX2
- 2) Browse to the folder with the RAW (NEF) files
- 3) Select 1 or all of the files you want to convert to JPEG
(CTRL + Click to select more than 1 file at a time)

NOTE: For Batch Processing of several photos at the same time, it's best to choose photos with Landscape or Portrait Orientation only. So choose several photos with Landscape orientation and continue with this tutorial.

- 4) From the Menu Bar,
 - a. click File
 - b. click Convert Files

5) The following Dialog Box comes up,

For Web or eMail use change the following parameters as follows:

- a. Change File Format to JPEG,
- b. Change Quality to High Quality, (click on slider bar),
- c. Change the image size, Long Edge for Landscape orientation to 1024, Long Edge for Portrait orientation to 768 pixels,
- d. Change Save in to The same folder as the original file, (your original file will remain intact because the new file with the same name will have a .JPG file extension; if you prefer to save it in a different folder, (for example, a sub-folder named JPEG, then do so.))

You are also presented with the option to Change file names if you prefer.


- e. Now click Convert and all of the files you had selected will be converted to JPEG so that you can use them on the Web, as an eMail attachment, or for BMCC digital image competitions.
